Message from Dean

I happened to travel with our Chief Mentor and a colleague, to attend a Conference at Bangalore. During the journey he started discussing about the role of organization culture in the growth of an organization. The discussion was more focused on the responsibilities of the senior colleagues and leader, in sustaining a healthy culture. Organization culture as we all know is built on a set of beliefs, values, code of personal and social conducts. These attributes are experienced by every individual irrespective of whether the person is new or a senior.

What happens to the culture when the composition of the employees undergoes a change? When different sets of people join the organization with different experience and exposure to varied culture, the role of senior colleagues becomes significant. Manage Your Stress and Save Your Brain

We are all familiar with stress. Stress happens each and every day. It comes in a wide variety of forms. When we face a potential threat, our minds and bodies go into action, mobilizing to either deal with the issue (fight) or avoid the problem (flight). Stress can lead to physical symptoms such as headaches and chest pain, mood problems such as anxiety, and behavioral problems such as increased smoking or overeating.

Stress can also have a serious impact on your brain. When you experience stress, your brain goes through a series of reactions designed to mobilize and protect itself from potential threats. Sometimes stress can help sharpen the mind and improve the ability to remember details. In other cases, stress can produce a wide range of negative effects on the brain.

Stress can lead to long term changes in the structure and function of the brain. These changes make one more prone to mood and anxiety disorders later on in life. Researchers suggest that stress might play a role in the development of mental disorders such as depression and various emotional disorders. Researchers have found that people suffering from post traumatic stress disorder have brain abnormalities including imbalances in gray and white matter.

Stress kills brain cells. Stress can lead to shrinkage in areas of the brain associated with the regulation of emotions, metabolism, and memory. Stress can affect your memory. Chronic stress negatively affects spatial memory as well as spatial orientation.

While stress is certainly a part of life that cannot be eliminated, researchers do believe that by understanding how stress affects the brain, they can gain insights into preventing the damage caused by stress.
