Dynamics of Labor Market in India

India is a country with large number of human resources where most of the resources are unutilized. On the other hand the industries have lots of demand for which the available human resources do not match. There is a huge gap between the existing demand and supply in the labor market. To understand this ear, fist we have to understand the categories of people constitute the Indian economy. The people as such are divided into three classes namely A, B and C. 'A' class people are the top of pyramid, these people have far above the ground annual income and live a luxury life. They can afford for the high price products and most important they are not affected by the inflation or deflation in the economy. The A Class people are not much responsive to the government policies which focus on the welfare of the citizen. In the middle of the pyramid we have 'B' class people. These people have moderate level of income and will be educated: they aspire to move into the top level of pyramid. They work hard to achieve that. They would be ready to take any work for their improvement in their standard of living. The government policies may not have that much effect on them but they will be concerned about the changes the government makes on these policies. On the other hand we have 'C' class people who constitute the bottom of pyramid. Their





income levels are very low and most of them are uneducated or school drop outs. So majority of the unskilled labor market are constituted by these people. Mostly they are very receptive to the government welfare policies.



In present scenario, the fact is the pyramid has transformed to diamond due to increase in the so called 'B' class middle income people. Since these people aspire to move to class 'A', most of them have chosen Information Technolory sector where the salay are high. Therefore people willing to opt for moderate income jobs are seen inumber which has contributed to the gap in demand and supply in labor market. Therefore the demand in the labor market has contributed to the like in labor cost. Moreover the Government Welfare Policies especially feetbes which are targeted on the C class people has also contributed in its own way to increase the gap between the demand and supply in labor market.
