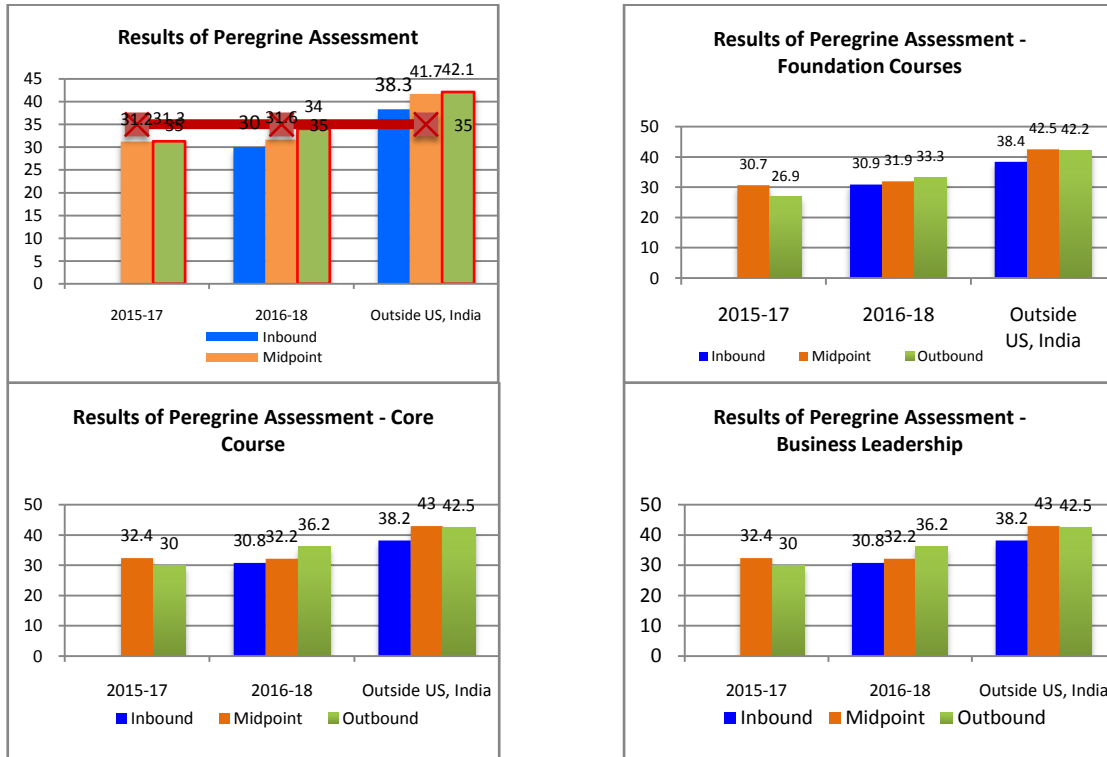

<b>PLO1:</b> Enhance the knowledge of business and management - To score 35 and above in Peregrine Outbound Assessment	Peregrine Assessment - External; Inbound and Midpoint Assessment - Formative; Outbound Assessment - Summative; Comparative - between batches, and outside US, India	<p>GRGSMS started using Peregrine assessment for outcome measurement from the academic year 2016-17 only. Hence the assessment scores for inbound, midpoint and outbound assessment are available for 2016-18 batch. The current results indicates that there is an improvement in the scores of students from inbound (30) to outbound (34) assessment.</p> <p>The results of Peregrine assessment for 2016-18 batch for Foundation Courses reveals that there is a gradual increase in the inbound (30.9) to midpoint (31.9) and midpoint to outbound (33.3) assessment.</p> <p>The results of Peregrine assessment for 2016-18 batch for Core Courses reveals that there is a gradual increase in the inbound (30.8) to midpoint (32.2) and midpoint to outbound (36.2) assessment.</p> <p>The results of Peregrine assessment for 2016-18 batch for the course Buisness Leadership reveals that there is an increase in the inbound (29.1) to midpoint (30.5) and as slight decrease from midpoint to outbound (28.2) assessment.</p>	Though there is an increase in assessment scores of 2016-18 batch from inbound to midpoint and outbound compared to that of 2015-17 batch, but we have not attained the set goal of scoring 35 and above in outbound assessment.	Increased use of experiential learning methods in all courses to provide opportunities that enable students to apply what they have learnt and relate the same to the happening in the business environment. Uploading videos, additional reading material etc on LMS have been regularly practiced. The results of the action taken are to be checked with the outbound scores of 2017-19 batch. Since there is a decrease in outbound scores of 2016-18 batch, hence the format of course delivery was modified. Students were provided with an opportunity to interview a successful women leader and later they shared their learning with their classmates. This exercise helped students understand the challenges faced by women in leadership positions and gave them insights as to how they should prepare themselves to takeup leadership positions. The results are to be checked with the outbound scores of 2017-19 batch.

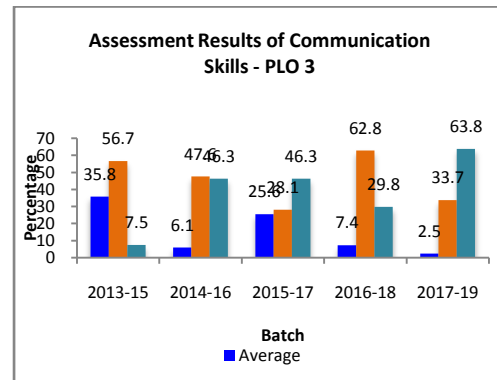
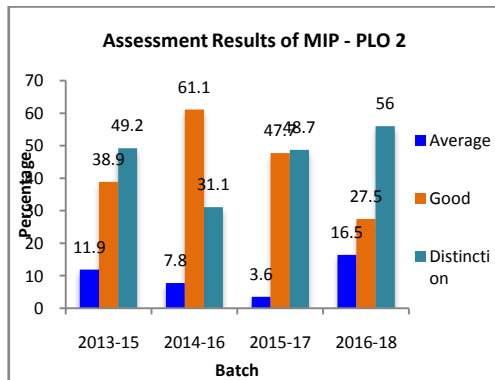
