#### SOCIAL CAPITAL

Social capital does not have a clear and undisputed meaning. Essentially social capital is a positive product of human interaction. The positive outcome may be tangible or intangible. It may include useful information, innovative ideas, and future opportunities. In business terms, social capital is the contribution to an organization's success that can be attributed to personal relationships and networks, both within the organization and outside of it.

Nahapiet and Ghoshal defined social capital as "the sum of the actual and potential resources embedded within, available through, and derived from the network of relationships possessed by an individual or social unit. Social capital thus comprises both the network and the assets that may be mobilized through that network".

According to Adler and Kwon (2002) "whereas market relationships are characterized by economic exchanges in which individuals trade goods or services for money, interpersonal relationships are characterized by social exchanges in which individuals exchange favours. When an individual grants a favour to another individual, he or she will receive a 'credit' or goodwill which can be used as a resource to facilitate the attainment of personal outcomes in the future". Social capital theory suggests that interpersonal

relations create value for individuals as they provide resources which can be used for the achieving desired outcomes.

Researchers have identified two basic forms of social capital. They are bonding and bridging. Bonding refers to social capital created within a group with shared interests and goals. A neighbourhood association is an example. Bridging is the creation of social capital across groups. If the bridging is successful, individuals in the two groups discover shared interests and goals and work together to achieve them. A neighbourhood association that links up with a local police department is an example.

Experts have concluded that social capital influences career success and executive compensation, Helps workers find jobs and creates a richer pool of recruits for firms, Facilitates interunit resource exchange and product innovation, Reduces turnover rates and organisational dissolution rates, Facilitates entrepreneurship, and Strengthens supplier relations. Social capital is as valuable as financial capital. One study estimated that nearly eighty-five per cent of jobs are filled through informal networking rather than through job listings. That is social capital in action.
